Different Internship models

- 2 kind of students
- Bachelor (ISSATSO and ISG) and engineers (ISSATso)



Engineers

- Internships (Mandatory)
 - 1 month in summer first year
 - 2 months in summer second year
 - 4 Months for the third year (end of studies project).
 - Sometimes they get paid (500 euros for French companies)
 - Some tunisien companies do pay the Internship.



Bachelor degree

- Internships:
 - first year and second year (optional)
 - 4 Months for the third year (end of studies project)
- Mandatory



How students find internships

- Mainly take contact by themselves with companies (Tunisien as well as European companies)
- They also take tests and might be selected upon their results out of the test.
- Usually they begin a kind of bootcamp about a technology or a set of technologies

Duties of the administration

- Official affectation of students to hosting companies
- Internships journal
- Sesame platform (for tracking the students)



Duties of the academics

- A supervisor for each end year project
 - Review reports
 - Review deliverables
 - Help for preparing the presentation and speech.
-
- Participate for defence of the projects and for the internships for the first and the second year.
 - This year we added a technical evaluation before the defence.

Trend of some companies

- Try to have students from their the second year.
- Engage them for the end year project (pre-employment contract)
- And then employment
